Challenges

Bridging the Gap for Seamless Meetings

The Seattle Kraken IT team envisioned a user-friendly and adaptable meeting space. However, translating this vision into reality presented a hat-trick of hurdles:

- Inefficient Solutions: Initial attempts relied on temporary setups like laptops and webcams, proving inadequate and time-consuming. Building a custom AV cart offered some improvement, but it remained cumbersome and lacked scalability for future considerations.
- **Distance and Power Obstacles:** Installing a highquality PTZ camera in the ceiling presented a major obstacle. Standard power was not readily available at the desired location, and traditional AV solutions could not support the camera's full functionality over a network connection (particularly with Zoom Rooms).
- Limited Options with Preferred Camera: The IT team favored the Aver Cam520 Pro PTZ camera due to its features, but it did not offer full functionality over network connections.

These combined challenges created a cost vs. functionality dilemma. Engaging professional integrators for a full AV system exceeded their budget, while traditional DIY solutions compromised both user experience and camera functionality. The Iceplex needed a solution that was not only efficient, but budget-friendly with the ability to overcome the technical limitations of distance and power access, allowing them to use their preferred camera.

The turning point came with the discovery of the <u>Icron USB 2.0 Ranger</u> <u>2304PoE</u>, with its ability to connect and extend USB 2.0 devices across a Power over Ethernet (PoE) enabled Gigabit Ethernet Local Area Network (LAN) using existing cabling. This eliminated the need for expensive electrical installations at the camera location. Its network functionality allowed the host computer to be located anywhere on the network, overcoming distance limitations that plagued previous solutions. A true game-changer!


